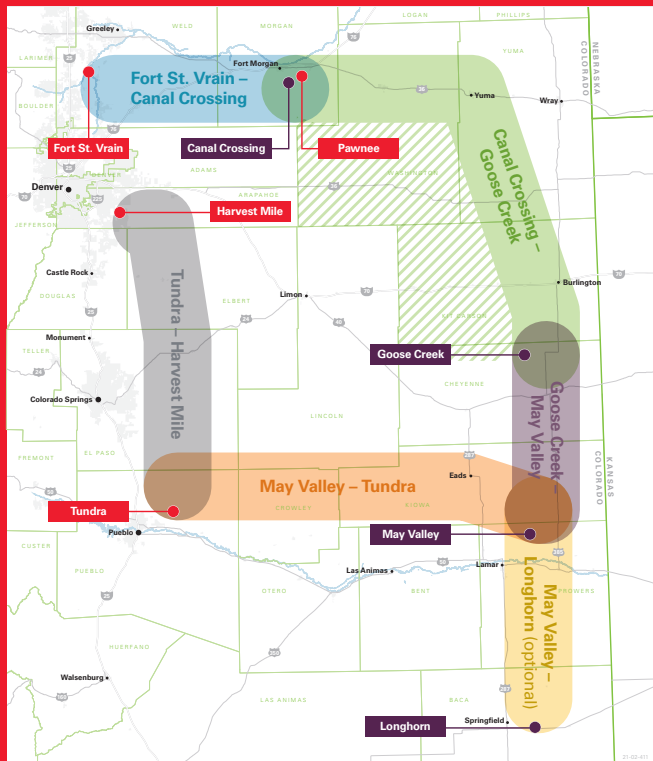

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Colorado's Power Pathway is a proposed 345-kilovolt transmission line in eastern Colorado. Routes have not been selected. We estimate the system will cross more than a dozen counties and include:

- Up to 650 miles of new transmission line
- Four new and four expanded substations
- The first transmission segments could be in-service in 2025, with other segments reaching completion in 2026 and 2027
