| Segment 5 Routing Update

Xcel Energy continues to make progress identifying the preferred transmission line route for Segment 5 (Tundra – Harvest Mile) of Colorado's Power Pathway. We have received a large amount of feedback from landowners and other stakeholders on Segment 5 route options which we continue to review. Based on this feedback, we are now evaluating potential additional route options in eastern Elbert County and western Lincoln County.

A preferred transmission line route has not been finalized, nor have we stopped considering existing Segment 5 route options in Pueblo, El Paso, Elbert and Arapahoe counties. A single, preferred route will be identified after the potential additional route options are evaluated. We anticipate this evaluation to be complete in fall 2022.

Additional open houses will take place in August in the new Segment 5 Eastern Review Area. Landowners in the Segment 5 Eastern Review Area will also receive open house information through the mail.

We kindly ask that open house attendees be limited to landowners and members of the public located in the Eastern Review Area so that we can provide one-on-one time with Project staff and gather feedback on the potential additional route options in this area.

| About the Project

Colorado's Power Pathway is a proposed \$1.7 to \$2 billion investment to improve the electric grid and enable future renewable energy development around the state. Colorado's Power Pathway includes approximately 560 to 650 miles of new 345-kilovolt electric transmission line and several new and expanded substations. If approved, segments of Colorado's Power Pathway could begin construction in 2023 and begin operating as early as 2025. The new infrastructure will increase electric reliability, connect new energy resources in eastern Colorado, boost the regional economy and create jobs during construction.
